



A SCHOOL CHARITY SPONSORED BY MISSION UPREACH



School is compulsory and free in Honduran society. Any child that wants to attend school can, according to the law. Unfortunately the reality of some Honduran children is very different. Children and their parents have to buy shoes, uniforms, note books, supplies, craft materials, and everything else that they will need during the school year.

For many children the strongest challenge to their attending school comes when their parents have to sacrifice their cash in order to purchase these needed items. Most of the rural families in Honduras are dependent on crops that only produce income for the family during one time of harvest each year. This money has to last the whole year. In the face of this challenge, parents often elect not to purchase the needed school items, which means their children cannot attend school.

Keeping Kids in School is a socially conscious project that is managed by Mission UpReach (www.missionupreach.com) in an effort to bring education and a better quality of life to needy children.

How do I participate? Two easy options:

Option One:

Step 1: Get a Keeping Kids in School Backpack from your local coordinator.

Step 2: Purchase all of the supplies listed under “Essential Supplies” and add any of the “Additional Supplies” that you would like to add.

Step 3: Fill out all of the information on the outside of the enclosed envelope.

Step 4: Place a check, made out to Mission UpReach, in the amount of \$12.00 in the envelope to cover the cost of the backpack, Bible and shipping and handling.

Step 5: Return the filled backpack along with the envelope containing your \$12.00 check to local coordinator. Mission UpReach will add a Spanish Bible to each backpack before giving it to a child.

Option Two:

Step 1: Get a donation envelope from your local coordinator.

Step 2: Fill out all of the information on the outside of the envelope.

Step 3: Place a check, made out to Mission UpReach, in the amount of \$35.00 in the envelope to cover cost of backpack, Bible, shipping and handling, and all items listed on the “Essential Supplies” list. Mission UpReach will buy all materials and put them inside the backpack before giving it to a child in their program.

Going the Extra Mile!

Choose between either Option 1 or Option 2 above and add an additional \$75.00 to your enclosed envelope to provide shoes, underwear and uniform for a child in our program for an entire school year.

1 pencil holder

4 simple art paint brushes

Tempera paints (*placed in a ziplock bag*)
